



2015 Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival Parade

General Rules and Regulations

1. The Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival Parade Committee will make its recommendations using your entry application. If your parade unit, on parade day, is different or differs greatly from your application, your unit may be dismissed from the parade while still in the assembly area.

2. No candy, samples or materials of any kind can be thrown or tossed from the Float/Specialty Unit while on parade.

Unit members walking near the crowd line may hand out items, with pre-approval by the Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival Parade Committee. Please list any items you would like to distribute on your application.

3. The Parade Review Committee will determine the order of appearance for all Units for the Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival Parade. The order is determined to establish variety, as well as best use of parade participants.

Your appearance location in the parade may be altered or canceled if your arrival in the assembly area is not the time established in your acceptance packet.

4. Once the parade has been assembled, all drivers should be in attendance at all times and available to move the Unit as necessary.

Your Unit should arrive at the assembly area one and a half (1 ½) hours prior to the 9 am start time of the Parade.

Unit support vehicles such as cars, buses, trucks and trailers must be promptly unloaded and moved out of the assembly area. No support vehicles will be allowed in the Parade.

5. Drivers of all vehicles in the Parade should have a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years of age, and have proper proof of insurance as required by state law.
6. At least one 4-pound dry chemical or one 10-pound carbon dioxide fire extinguisher must be placed within easy reach of the driver of the motorized tow vehicle of the Parade Unit.
7. Individuals and organizations participating in the Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival Parade are expected to perform courteously and in good taste and with safety in mind at all times during the assembly, progress and dispersal of the parade.
8. The consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages by any parade participant is strictly prohibited. The illegal use of controlled substances by any parade participant is also strictly prohibited.

The Unicoi County Sheriff's Department will enforce all City, County, and State statutes concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages and the use of illegal controlled substances before, during, and after the Parade.

If this policy is broken, the Unit will be pulled from the Parade, the offender will be subject to arrest, and the Unit will NOT be asked to participate in future Wayne Scott Strawberry Festival parades.

Security And Liability

Sponsors and promoters of the 2014 Town of Unicoi Christmas Parade and their agents, employees, and the Town of Unicoi shall not be liable for loss of personal property, personal injury, or other damages involving parade participant or participant's agents and employees. Participant shall defend and indemnify sponsors and promoters of the Town of Unicoi Christmas Parade from any and all claims, liabilities, expenses, damages and penalties caused or incurred by wrongful acts of participant, or participant's agents and employees, including breach of Parade Rules and Regulations. Participant shall secure and maintain adequate liability and property insurance.
