Heritage Museum Trail
 Distance: 0.5 miles
 Difficulty: 1
 Easily accessible educational hike that is good for small children

Erwin Linear Trail
 Distance: 4.2 miles
 Difficulty: 1
 Paved family friendly trail for walking, biking, and running

Pinnacle Fire Tower Trail
 Distance: 4.9 miles
 Difficulty: 3
 Gradual incline rewarded with 360° view from fire tower

Red Fork Falls
 Distance: 0.5 mile
 Difficulty: 2
 Fun and adventurous trail leading to a magnificent 60 foot waterfall

Sill Branch Falls
 Distance: 1 mile
 Difficulty: 2
 Smooth path leading to an impressive 40 foot waterfall

Lower Higgins Falls and Birchfield Camp Lake
 Distance: 6 miles
 Difficulty: 3
 Follows a cascading waterfall and ascends up to a mountaintop lake

Indian Grave Gap to Iron Mtn Gap
 Distance: 10.7 miles
 Difficulty: 4
 Diverse fauna and mountain-top meadow with extensive views of two states

Rock Creek Falls
 Distance: 2 miles
 Difficulty: 2.5
 Wide path dotted with creek crossings ascending to a beautiful 50 foot waterfall

Rocky Fork Trail
 Distance: 0.5 mile
 Difficulty: 1
 Wide, steady trail following a picturesque creek

Sams Gap to Spivey Gap
 Distance: 13.4 miles
 Difficulty: 5
 Outstanding views of Appalachian Mountains from highest peak in Unicoi County
